(John 4)</p>	<p>29 May Day 3</p> <p>Multicultural Nth America</p> <p>Pray for strength, funds and unity for churches, NGO's and missionaries working among Muslims in US cities. (Ephesians 6:1-4)</p>

(Romans 15:17-21)</p>

(Mark 10:13-16)</p>	<p>11 June Day 16</p> <p>Bakar's Story - Malaysia</p> <p>Malaysia has a growing drug problem, despite tough laws. Pray for Christians to live the gospel message, loving the unlovable, and in that way be a living testimony. (Luke 10:27)</p>	<p>12 June Day 17</p> <p>Ishelhayn Berbers, Morocco</p> <p>Berbers are interested in different ways of thinking. Pray they will have an opportunity to hear about Jesus through satellite TV or through meeting believers. (1 Chron 16:8-11)</p>	<p>13 June Day 18</p> <p>Minangkabau of West Sumatra</p> <p>Pray that influential Minangkabau women will be good role models. Pray that whole families to experience new life in Jesus.
